

Who can participate?

- Refugees
 - All asylumseekers having entered Germany after 01.08.2019
 - Tolerated persons close to the job market*, i.e. unemployed, seeking employment or apprenticeship, in vocational training, in vocational preparation (*if no BAMF access)
- Immigrants
- EU Citizens

Who cannot participate?

- Anyone participating in a BAMF course
- Tolerated persons with pending deportation
- Tolerated persons from: Albania, Bosnia, Herzegovina, Kosovo, Macedonia, Montenegro, Serbia, Senegal and Ghana
- Children, Youths and Adults currently attending school
- Anyone who has used up their BAMF hours

What course?

- Usually consists of 300 teaching units
- Full or part time courses available
- Similar content to BAMF courses
- If necessary, morning, afternoon and evening lessons possible
- Special formats (i.e. courses for women or parents) tbd

How much does the course cost?

- Participation is free of charge
- Books and study material must be purchased by participants at their own expense
- travel ticket to the course location must be purchased by participants – can be reimbursed up to 50% if:
 - Single trip > 3km
 - 80% participation rate (regardless of excused- unexcused absence)
 - Least costly connection using public transport was chosen (private car usage only with prior request)
 - Original tickets are provided upon request

Which rules are there to note?

- Please attend all classes on time whenever possible
- In case of sickness, please inform the school about your absence ahead of class begin via email or phone
- Provide a doctor's certification (this also applies when your child is sick and requires medical attention)
- Please keep travel tickets safely stored
- Please bring all course material
- Please actively participate in class, do not disturb the class and respect those around you
